EARLY THAW SHOWS – Rules and General Information

1. All classes will be run in accordance with the American Quarter Horse Association (AQHA) and the American Paint Horse Association (APHA) rules, 2012 revised edition. Horses must have AQHA or APHA registration papers (excepting current year foals, which must be shown unnamed if not yet registered.) Registration papers, Amateur, Novice Amateur, and Youth cards will be inspected by the show secretary. These shows are approved by AQHA, UQHA, APHA, and NQHA.
2. No refunds.
3. Classes must be pre-entered with at least one entry per horse, or you will be charged a \$25 post entry fee. Send entries and a photocopy of papers to Debbie Bartholomew, 570 North 2200 East, Preston, ID 83263, postmarked no later than February, 17 2012 to avoid the post entry fee. E-mail address debbieshows@aol.com *Payment need not accompany entry.*
4. Cattle classes may be canceled if less than 3 entries. Cattle class entries close February 11, 2012.
5. All adds and scratches to classes must be done at the show office, at least three classes prior.
6. **To qualify for show all around awards you must show in the corresponding halter class for your division and show in at least five performance events** (respective Amateur halter class for Amateur or Novice Amateur all around; respective Youth halter class for Youth or Novice Youth all around, and Open halter class for Open all around)
7. Exhibitors may park their RV's and motor homes on the show grounds. Any power hookups must be reserved through the fairgrounds first. Electrical hookups are limited with electricity only. Call the Washington County Fair Park (435-)652-4000 for reservations on a first come first served basis.
8. Ties will be broken by a tie-breaker judge.
9. Checks are to be made payable to EARLY THAW SHOWS.. Payments must be in U.S. funds. Any checks returned for insufficient funds will be charged \$25.00. Any awards earned may be withheld pending payment in full.
10. MDH Enterprises, Early Thaw Shows, the American Paint Horse Association, the Utah Quarter Horse Association, the Nevada Quarter Horse Association and the American Quarter Horse Association, or any of their representatives are not responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and each exhibitor shall hold these entities, the show management, and Washington County blameless for sickness, fire, theft or other causes. All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damage done by them or their agents, to the barn and properties of the show grounds, and will be billed accordingly.
11. **Speakers in the barn are for the convenience of the exhibitors, But it does NOT relieve you of the responsibility of being ready for your class(es).**
12. Prizes awarded for first place. "Thaw Bucks" will be awarded to second through fifth place in all regular classes. These may be redeemed at the concession stand or the vendor trailer(s) for \$1 in merchandise (each). No change will be given
13. Every sixth place exhibitor will receive a ticket for the \$100 drawing, which is the exhibitor's responsibility to fill out and deposit in the entry box in the officel
14. **No exhibitor numbers will be handed out from the office without leaving an open check!!**

EARLY THAW FUTURITY & CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

RULES FOR BOTH YOUTH FUTURITIES:

1. Open to all breeds – horses need not be registered. (Mares or geldings only – no stallions.)
2. Montana Silversmith buckles awarded to the winner in Leadline and Walk Trot Youth – no paybacks will be awarded
3. Prizes awarded second thru sixth place.
4. Release form must be signed for each youth exhibitor, BY PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN.
5. Ties will be decided by the tie-breaker judge.
6. Exhibitors must show same horse in all classes.
7. Age of exhibitor as of January 1, 2012.
8. Exhibitors may also show in regular paint youth and quarter horse youth classes.
9. Handlers in Leadline class must be at least 18 years of age.

YOUTH LEADLINE FUTURITY (6 & Under as of Jan 1, 2012)

YOUTH WALK/TROT FUTURITY (7 –11 as of Jan 1, 2012)

1. **Entry fee is \$50 – entries close Feb 17, 2012. *Payment must accompany entry.***

2. Exhibitors will be judged according to APHA Youth Walk/Trot guidelines
3. Break of trot to lope for 5 strides or more will disqualify the entry in that class.
4. Exhibitor/Horse must be the same for all classes.
5. Must show in all 5 events to receive awards.

NOVICE AMATEUR WALK/TROT CHAMPIONSHIP RULES (19 and older as of Jan 1, 2012)

1. Entry fee of \$25– entries close Feb 17, 2012. *Payment must accompany entry.* Post entries, at double entry fee, will be accepted until 8:00 am on Feb 24. Send entries to: Debbie Bartholomew, 570 N 2200 E, Preston, ID 83263. Any Questions Phone (208-852-1698)
2. Exhibitors must be eligible for Novice Amateur status with APHA or AQHA, but must NOT have earned any performance points in ANY breed association (excluding Showmanship at Halter)
3. Exhibitors will be judged at Western Pleasure and horsemanship. Same exhibitor/horse combination.
4. Prizes will be awarded to the top six places. No paybacks will be awarded.
5. Montana Silversmith buckle to winner
6. Open to all breeds – horses need not be registered. (Mares or geldings only – no stallions.)
